Perceptions of Residents in Communities to be served by Family Centers

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Highlights


Residents living in the seven communities to be served by Family Centers supported by the Brighter Futures Initiative of the Hartford Foundation for Public Giving were surveyed in March, 2002. A total of 1,208 residents were interviewed from households where at least one child eight years old or younger was living.

Characteristics of households


- One (29%) or two (33%) children lived in the majority of households.
- Children lived with two parents in 45% of homes and with a single parent in 46% of homes.
- About a third of the adults surveyed had more than a high school education (35%); a quarter (27%) had less.
- Literacy activities with children
 - Almost all the parents surveyed (93%) read with their children; two-thirds (62%) did so every day.
 - Half of the homes (48%) had a computer, and children used the computer in most of these homes (81%).
- > Recreational activities with children
 - **u** Two-thirds (66%) of the parents do fun things with their children every day.
- Children's health care
 - About a third of the families have children with health problems; the most common health problem was asthma (75% of families with health problems).
 - One in seven families (13%) wish they had more food to feel their children or report that their children go hungry because there is not enough food to feed them.
 - □ Almost one in five families (18%) have children with special needs.
- Child care
 - Most families (82%) have a place where they can leave their children when they need child care; most of these families (86%) leave their children with family members.
 - Those who leave children with other than family members report they are very satisfied (82%) with their child care arrangements and believe the place does a good job preparing their children to do well in school (98%).
- > Involvement in children's school
 - Almost all of the parents (96%) with children in school have been to the school this year.
 - Most have been to the school to attend a teacher's conference (76%) and to get a report card (52%).
 - The majority find the information the school sends home understandable (82%).
 - □ Parents feel welcome in their children's school most of the time (89%).
- Quality of neighborhood
 - The majority of people rate their neighborhoods as excellent or good in terms of:
 - ✓ The quality of schools (63%)
 - ✓ After-school programs (55%)
 - ✓ A safe place to raise a family (53%)
 - ✓ Child care for pre-school children (51%)
 - The majority of people rate their neighborhoods as only fair or poor in terms of:
 - ✓ Places to do things together as a family (56%)
 - ✓ Police protection (53%)
 - ✓ Programs to help children do better in school (51%)

- Sources of support
 - Almost everyone (92%) has someone they can call on when they need help
- Perception of ability to increase school readiness
 - Almost everyone (92%) believes parents can do things to increase school readiness for their children.
 - □ The majority believe parents can teach children numbers and letters (64%), read to their children (60%), and talk to their children (56%).
- ➢ Use of family center
 - The majority of families report they would definitely use a family center if it provided:
 - ✓ Summer programs for children (77%)
 - ✓ Play groups for preschool children (69%)
 - ✓ Activities for family to do together (66%)
 - ✓ Preschool programs (66%)
 - ✓ Tutoring or homework help for children (65%)
 - ✓ Cultural programs (64%)
 - ✓ Classes to teach parents how to support their children (60%)
 - ✓ Anger management for dealing with children (55%)
 - ✓ Classes on money management (52%)
 - ✓ Leadership training classes (51%)
 - The majority would definitely or probably use a family center if it provided:
 - Parenting classes (79%)
 - ✓ Adult literacy classes (66%)
 - ✓ Adult ESL classes (66%)
 - ✓ GED classes (65%)
 - ✓ Prenatal care classes (59%)
 - □ The preferred times to use family centers are on weekends (47%) and evenings (43%)




How many children live here altogether?




Percent of families with children...




Who are the adults living in the home?






How would you rate the quality of schools in this neighborhood...




How would you rate places to do things together as a family in this neighborhood?




How would you rate child care for preschool children in this neighborhood?







How would you rate police protection in this neighborhood?












How do they perceive parents' ability to increase school readiness?








Would you use activities for parents and children to do together if they were made available at a Family Center in this neighborhood?




Would you use classes to help adults read better if they were made available at a Family Center in this neighborhood?




